November 2020 school trustee mid-term elections Board Chair and Principals Memo 1

Kia ora,

Our records show that your school is due to hold mid-term elections in November 2020. If this is not the case, please contact us so that we can update our records.

NZSTA is committed to supporting boards and schools to run successful elections.

Throughout the election period, we will provide regular updates and resources to ensure schools have all the information they need to promote participation in the election and attract candidates who reflect the diversity within their community.

Please note that as the majority of schools held their triennial election in June 2019 we will be aiming most communications towards the recommended date for these schools of 4th December 2020. Please disregard mentions in future communications regarding a December election date as this does not apply to you. You must hold your mid-term election in November.

Updated regulations

An amendment has recently been passed to the Education (School Trustee Elections) Regulations. These new regulations come into effect from 1 September 2020.

Please note: the proposed changes will **NOT** apply to the Student trustee elections in September 2020 or any by-election that has commenced prior to 1 September 2020.

2020 mid-term elections will follow the new regulations.

The key changes are that the election's timeline has been extended and the requirements around using the postal system have been removed. You can read the full amendment [here](#).

Recommended election date

Friday 27 November 2020 is the recommended election date for schools who must hold their mid-term elections in November 2020. If your school chooses to use this date, the following table gives you all the key dates you need to meet. You can also create your own timetable using our [election planner tool](#)):

Close Main Roll	Friday 2 October 2020
Call for Nominations by	Sunday 4 October 2020
Close Supplementary Roll	Noon, Friday 23 October 2020
Nominations Close	Noon, Sunday 25 October 2020
Voting Papers issued by	Friday 30 October 2020
Election Day (voting closes)	4pm, Friday 27 November 2020
Accept postal votes	Wednesday 2 December 2020
Count Votes	Thursday 3 December 2020
Board Takes Office	Thursday 10 December 2020

Boards need to start planning for the elections now.

Put it on the agenda for your next Board meeting and look to confirm your election date, discuss appointing a Returning Officer and develop a plan for promoting the elections in your community.
